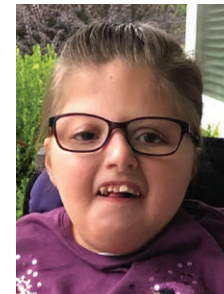

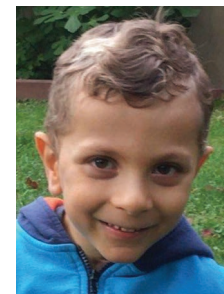

About the beneficiaries

Julia is a 9 year-old who attends 3rd grade at Copper Hill School. Just weeks after her birth, she was diagnosed with Trisomy 9 Mosaicism (T9M), a rare chromosomal disorder that affects each child differently.

Julia has been diagnosed with Craniosynostosis (the premature fusing of her skull), intestinal malrotation, hip dysplasia, laryngomalacia, mild sensorineural hearing loss, seizure disorder, low muscle tone, severe global developmental delays and scoliosis. She is fed through a gastronomy tube, is non-verbal and currently uses a wheelchair for mobility.

Despite all of the challenges she has faced, Julia demonstrates incredible resilience. She is a happy little girl who loves to share her smile and spreads joy wherever she goes.

Her parents and siblings (Sofia and Louie) appreciate the support they've received from their family, friends and community.

Christian is a 6-year-old student at Branchburg's Midland School. He was born prematurely at 26 weeks and weighed barely 2 pounds 4 ounces. Christian was in three hospitals for 201 days. In that time, he needed tracheostomy surgery for subglottal stenosis and a gastric feeding tube for all his nutrition. When he was two years old, he was also diagnosed with autism and developmental delays. He is no longer using a trach after trachea reconstruction surgery in 2020, but he continues to use his gastric feeding tube.

Christian works hard every day with his therapists, both in school and outside of school.

"Christian is a little miracle who has overcome numerous obstacles," says his mom, Marissa. "Despite this, he is a cheerful and intelligent young man who enjoys singing, counting, reading, as well as exploring outside and playing on the playground. We are grateful for the help we have gotten from our family, friends, and the community."
