About the beneficiaries

Julia is a 7 year-old who attends 1st grade at Copper Hill School. Just weeks after her birth, she was diagnosed with Trisomy 9 Mosaicism (T9M), a rare chromosomal disorder that affects each child differently.

Julia has been diagnosed with Craniosynostosis (the premature fusing of her skull), intestinal malrotation, hip dysplasia, laryngomalacia, mild sensorineural hearing loss, seizure disorder, low muscle tone, severe global developmental delays and scoliosis. She is fed through a gastronomy tube, is non-verbal and currently uses a wheelchair for mobility.

Despite all of the challenges she has faced, Julia demonstrates incredible resilience. She is a happy little girl who loves to share her smile and spreads joy wherever she goes.

Her parents and siblings (Sofia and Louie) appreciate the support they've received from their family, friends and community.

Bryan is a fun-loving, determined, young adult with an infectious laugh. He attends The Midland School in North Branch, NJ.

Shortly after birth, Bryan was diagnosed with spastic dysplasia cerebral palsy and was later also diagnosed with autism. He has since received diagnoses of anxiety disorder, obsessive compulsive disorder, and ADHD. Bryan requires constant supervision as he lacks the concept of danger and his self-help skills are that of a young child.

Bryan has undergone several procedures and long surgeries at Children's Specialized Hospital and Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP) to help better his quality of life. Bryan is primarily wheelchair-bound but also uses a walker to help strengthen his legs. He would love to be able to do the simple things some people take for granted, such as use an escalator! Bryan receives occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech therapy, equestrian therapy and ABA therapy.

Bryan attends sleep away summer camp where he has made great progress in social and life skills. He enjoys spending time outdoors, whether it is riding his adaptive trike, laying on the trampoline while his 2 sisters (Coryn & Madison) bounce him around or going for walks with his best friend, his service dog Artie.
